GENERAL RULES

- 1. All entries must be the project of a youth under the age of 20 as of **October 1, 2019**. AJCA age rules apply where applicable. Exhibitors who do not qualify under AJCA rules may compete for show premium only. Registration open to youth from Arkansas and Southern Missouri ONLY, NO Exceptions. Show reserves to right to request proof of age.
- 2. Each exhibitor or exhibitor's group must be the owner of the animals they show. Show reserves the right to request identification and proof of ownership.
- 3. Registration must be made prior to weigh-in. Pre-registration before show day is appreciated, show not responsible for lost or late entries. Early registrations forms may be emailed to crowleysridgeclassic@gmail.com, payment may be made day of show at time of check in by debit/credit card or cash will be accepted.
- 4. All animals must be shown and cared for by the junior exhibitor. The animal must be shown by the exhibitor unless granted a waiver due to extenuating circumstances by the rules of the Executive Committee.
- 5. Each exhibitor is limited to 2 animals per class. No limit to total entries.
- 6. All AJCA rules will apply. (Rules available upon request).
- 7. A \$15.00 entry fee will be charged per animal. No refunds for any reason.
- 8. All animals entering the grounds must meet the health requirements of their particular species and will be inspected at the show for any evidence of diseases. Any animals exhibiting the symptoms of an active disease will be denied access to the grounds.
- 9. Swine must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 30 days of show reflecting the following:
 - A. All animals are to be tested negative for Brucellosis within 30 days of show or originate from a validated herd, with validation number and date of last herd test shown on certificate.
 - B. Animals to be tested negative for pseudorabies within 30 days of show or originate from a Qualified Pseudorabies Free Herd.
 - C. Free of other contagious, infectious and communicable diseases (erysipelas, atrophic Rhinitis, etc.)
 - D. All swine must have an 840 identification tag in place on arrival.
- 10. Cattle health regulations are as follows:
 - A. Breeding cattle must have health certificates.
 - B. All heifers must be calf-hood vaccinated and noted on health certificate.
 - C. Steers shall be subject to health inspection on show grounds if sickness is suspected
- 11. All sheep and goats must have scrapies tag in place.
- 12. There are no livestock weight or age limits other than those imposed by a particular sanctioning organization for that particular species.
- 13. No animal with a rupture or unhealed cut may be shown.
- 14. Each exhibitor is responsible for getting his animal into and out of the ring at the designated time.
- 15. Entries in showmanship are not required to have shown in the competitive show classes. Showmanship classes will compete as follows: Age as October 1, 2019

 Pee-Wee 8 and under, Junior 9 13, Senior 14-20
- 16. No livestock may be removed until released. All livestock must be removed from the fairgrounds within 2 hours after close of show or forfeit all prize money.
- 17. The show board and the Greene County Fairgrounds are not liable for any loss, damages or injury to any animal or exhibitor during the show. All exhibitors must have a signed waiver on file.
- 18. All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
- 19. All exhibitors must clean pens or stalls after the show and remove bedding material from the grounds. Bedding not provided.
- 20. Any violation of these rules by an exhibitor can cause loss of prize money and / or disciplinary action.
- 21. All exhibitors will be expected to maintain the same standards of conduct required by their school or organization.
- 22. Any animals abused or neglected in any way, as determined by the show board, will result in forfeiture of prize money and / or the exhibitor being expelled from the show.
- 23. Rules posted on the day of the show supersede all other published rules.
- 24. In the spirit of good sportsmanship The decision of the judge is final. The show board will not hear grievances resulting from the decision of the judge.

Market Rabbit Rules

Meat Pen Rabbits:

MEAT PEN DEFINITION: A Meat Pen will consist of three (3) rabbits of the same color, preferably of the same breed, but mixed breeds will be acceptable. The animal must weigh at least 3 ½ pounds and no more than 5 ½ pounds each. Rabbits cannot be over ten weeks old. Animals may come from different litters. The trio should be uniform.

1. TATTOOS: Meat Pens must have a tattoo in the left ear---rabbits must have an individual rabbit identification number—issued by the exhibitor.

DUAL ENTRY: Rabbits entered in the Single Fryer Competition **CANNOT** be entered as part of a Meat Pen Trio. **Exception:** A meat pen entered that has a mortality that would disqualify the entry, may have one rabbit designated by owner and signed by agent/advisor to be moved to single fryer. Only one meat pen entry is eligible for this exception.

Single Fryer Rabbits:

SINGLE FRYER DEFINITION: One Rabbit—not over 10 weeks of age. Rabbit must weigh at least 3 ½ pounds and no more than 5 ½ pounds.

1. TATOOS: Single Fryers must have a tattoo in the left ear—rabbits must have an individual rabbit identification number –issued by the exhibitor.

Dual ENTRY: Rabbits entered in the Single Fryer Competition **CANNOT** be entered as part of a Meat Pen.

Jr Rabbit Show

Any rabbit may be entered by declaring on the entry form one of the breeds listed below. Entry shall declare breed (use breed from list below), sex, age classification and color or variety.

Special Rules

- 1. All rabbits must be placed on the judging table by a youth exhibitor. Only authorized show personnel will be allowed behind the show table.
- 2. Crowley's Ridge Classic reserves the right to add or substitute judges.
- 3. This is a carrying cage show, leak proof carriers are required.
- 4. Any animal showing signs or symptoms of disease will be removed from the show promptly by show superintendent or other show personnel.
- 5. When entering, rabbits' age should be based on how old they will be on the day of show.
- 6. Crowley's Ridge Classic is not responsible for any loss from fire, theft, accidents, death of rabbit or providential destruction during the show.
- 7. All rabbits must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.

CLASSES

- 1. Pre Jr Doe (Does under 3 months of age)
- 2. Jr Doe (Does 3-6 months of age)
- 3. Intermediate Doe (Doe 6-8 months of age-commercial breeds)
- 4. Sr Doe (Does 6 months or older)
- 5. Pre Jr Buck (Bucks under 3 months of age)
- 6. Jr Buck (Bucks 3-6 months of age)
- 7. Intermediate Buck (Bucks 6-8 months of age-commercial breeds)
- 8. Sr Buck (Bucks 6 months or older)

All rabbits must have a left ear tattoo assigned by the exhibitor for identification.
